

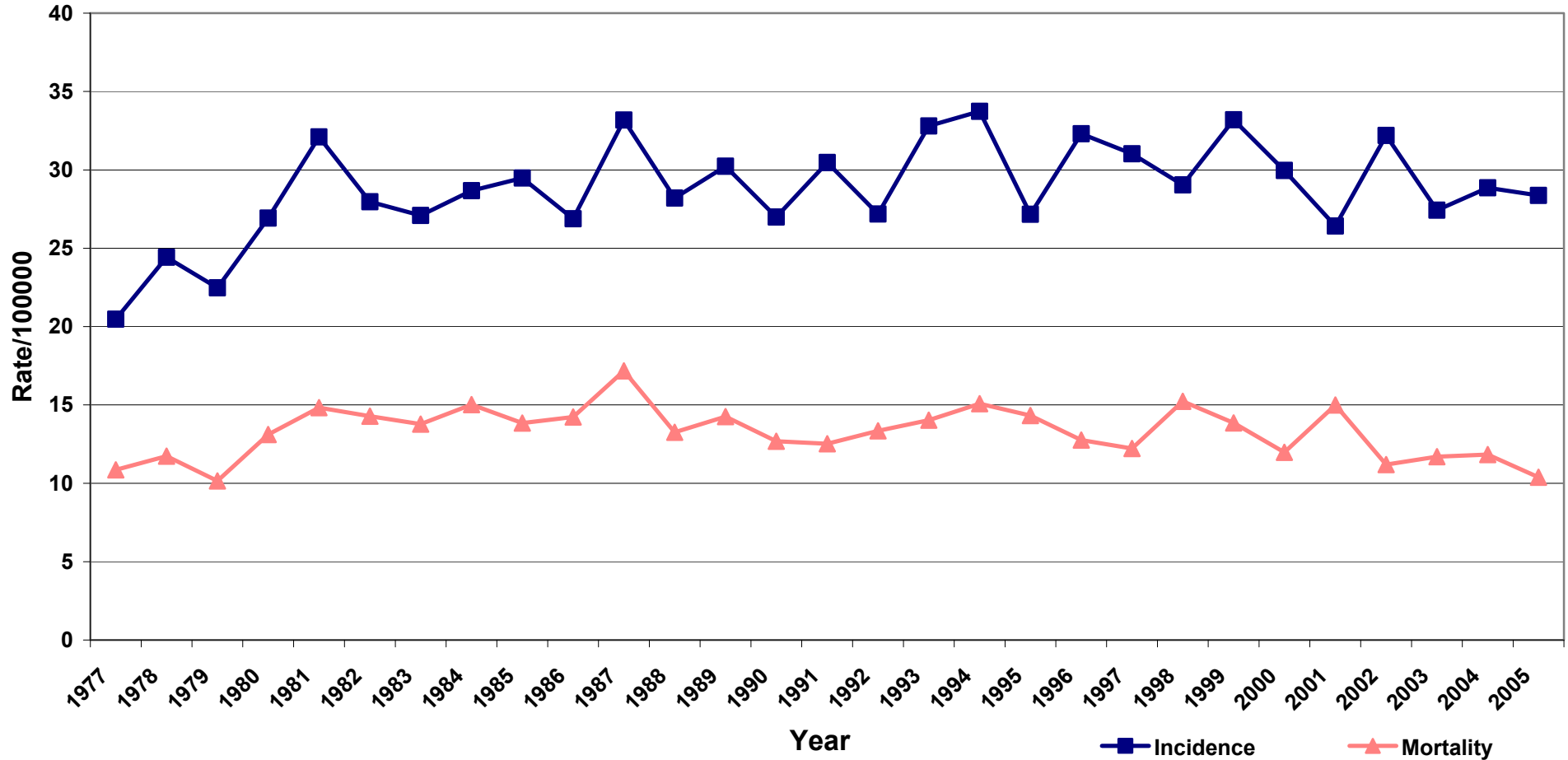
## Rectal Cancer

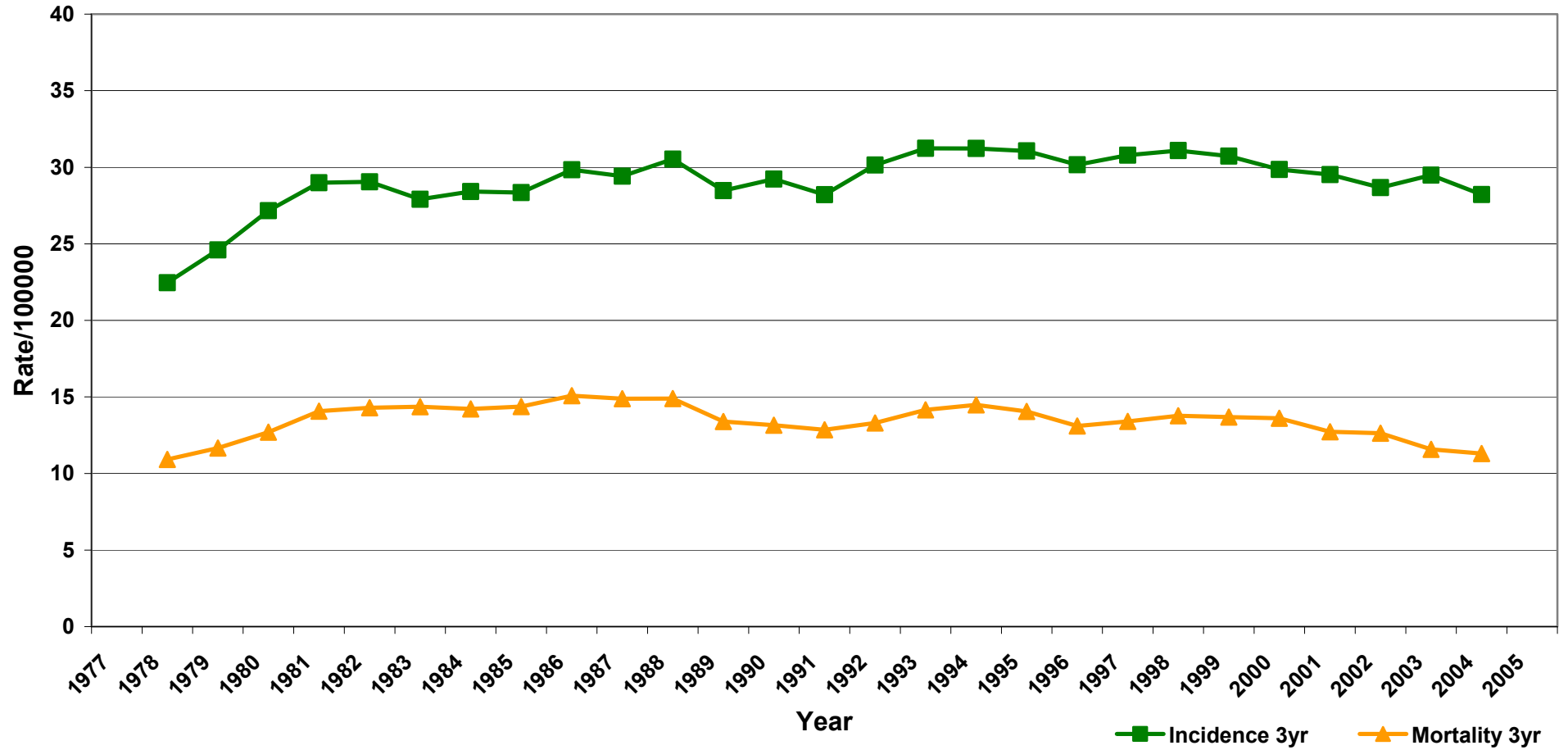

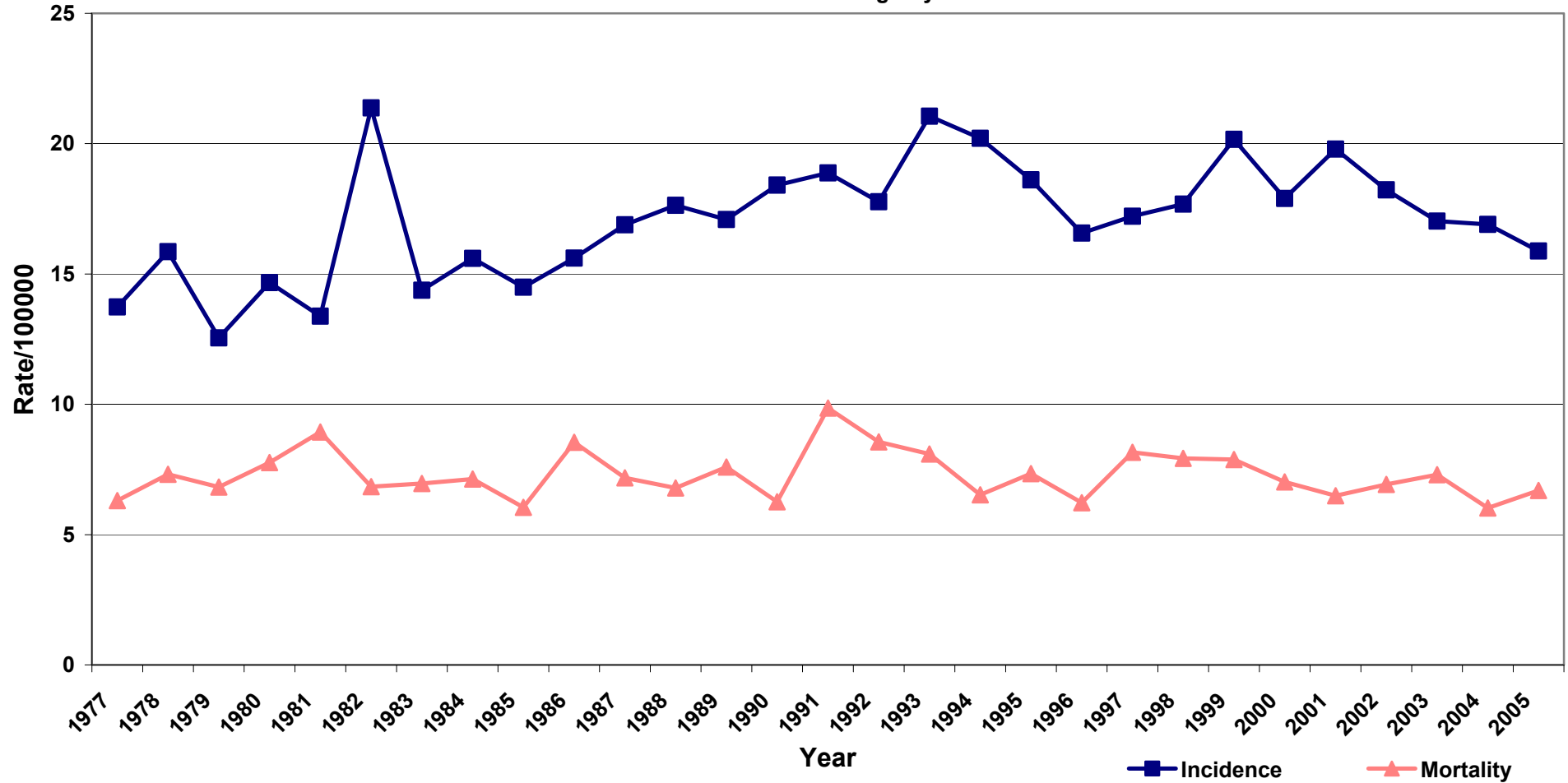

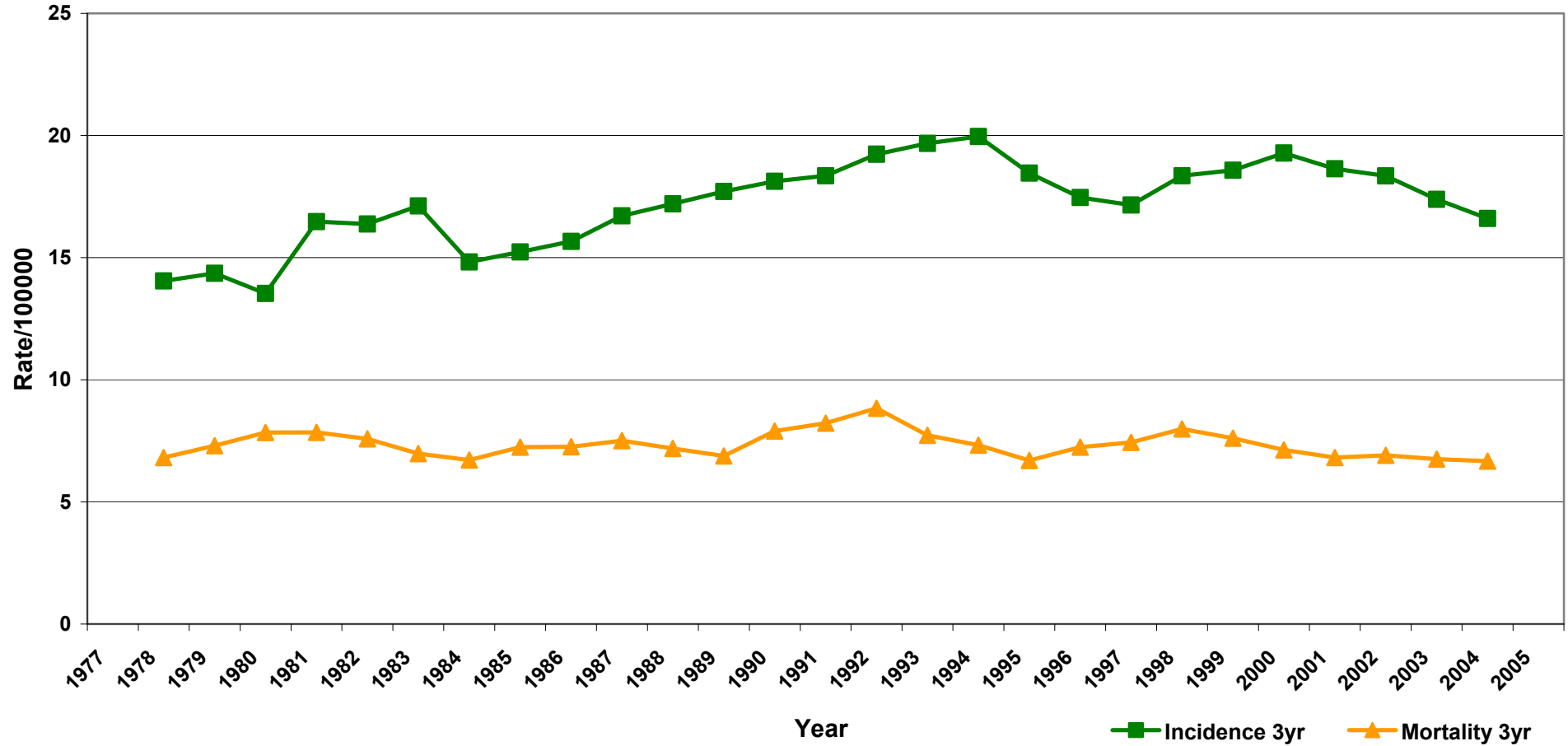
