- Recycled water from Mawson Lakes is the highest quality available and has the fewest restrictions.
- Recycled water from Glenelg Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP), while of a high quality is not as good as that from Mawson Lakes. Water from Glenelg is not suitable for supply to secondary storages (domestic tanks) or for use in car washes.
- Use of recycled water from other sources will be considered on a case-by-case basis but will be subject to extended restrictions to protect public health.

General Approval Conditions

- The recycled water will be transported/stored in a dedicated vehicle/vessel that is not used to transport/store drinking water, recycled water of a lesser quality or chemicals. It will be signed as such, i.e. "recycled water-not for drinking".
- Recycled water will not be allowed to pool or run off the site of use or into the stormwater system.
- If used for industrial purposes, recycled water contact with the public should be minimised.
